MAILBOX KEYS AND LOCKS

The Home Owners' Association does not have replacement keys for mailboxes. If you lose your key put a note on the mailbox door stating "Lost key, please remove lock". The carrier will remove the lock and place it inside the mailbox. This means your mail will not be protected temporarily. You may want to have your mail held at the post office until you have gotten a replacement lock/key set. You can search "C9100 USPS-L-1172C" to find a replacement lock/key set that matches the current locks in the mailboxes. Home improvement stores may have replacement sets but they may not fit exactly.

MONTHLY MEETINGS

Our monthly meetings are held on the second Wednesday of the month at 7PM at the fire station. A sign is placed at the front of the development as a reminder and if necessary will denote any change in location.
